This year we are limited to only a few classes to be raced to make it more spectator friendly.

Your invite is up to comp committee vote. You will receive your invite and pit passes in the mail in June of 2010. Your Pit Passes are to be worn on the outside for officials to see it. This gives you access in the Staging Lane, if not worn you will not be able to be in the staging lanes. This is to keep out spectator...
